For nearly 50 years MRFD Station #4 has called Piltzville home. Operations will soon commence at a new location leaving the future use of the existing facility unknown.

Station 4 is uniquely situated because it is surrounded on three sides by residential property nestled in the heart of a neighborhood. In contrast, the remaining four MRFD stations are located in primarily commercial settings. While MRFD has been a "good neighbor" the uncertainty of a new occupant is concerning and warrants public involvement and input as MRFD moves forward with sale of this property.

Clearly, there are opportunities that would safeguard quality of life, improve property values and enhance the neighborhood. This petition, addressed to the MRFD Board of Trustees, reflects a shared concern regarding the future use of the Piltzville facility.

To date there has been no outreach to the local community regarding MRFD's intention for the property. As taxpayers, we respectfully request a place at the table to help ensure a compatible future use of this property that compliments rather than detracts from the neighborhood and community at large.







